These instructions are for the queen size quilt. You can make adjustments for your chosen size. If you need assistance, any of the BOM Squad will be happy to assist.

1) The Center section is the challenge to match properly. We suggest you assemble the blocks as shown. This method has only 2 long sections to match up. simplifying the overall assembly of a large quilt.

2) Assemble your blocks as shown creating 3 rows.


Once the center is assembled you are ready to add your borders. You decide if you want to cut your borders along the straight of grain length of fabric or piece from WOF strips. The length given is the finished length if all your squares are finished at 9 ". These are not mitered corners.

First Border - Right and Left Side: cut (2) $-11 / 2$ " x $811 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ long Strips.

- Top and bottom: Cut (2) $-11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 831 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips


1 patch

Middle Border

- Right and Left Side: Cut (2) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 831 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips

- Top and bottom: Cut (2) $-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 891 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips


1 patch

Outside (3rd Border)

- Right and Left Side: Cut (2) $6^{\prime \prime} \times 891 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips


1 patch

- Top and bottom: Cut (2) $-6^{\prime \prime} \times 1001 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
