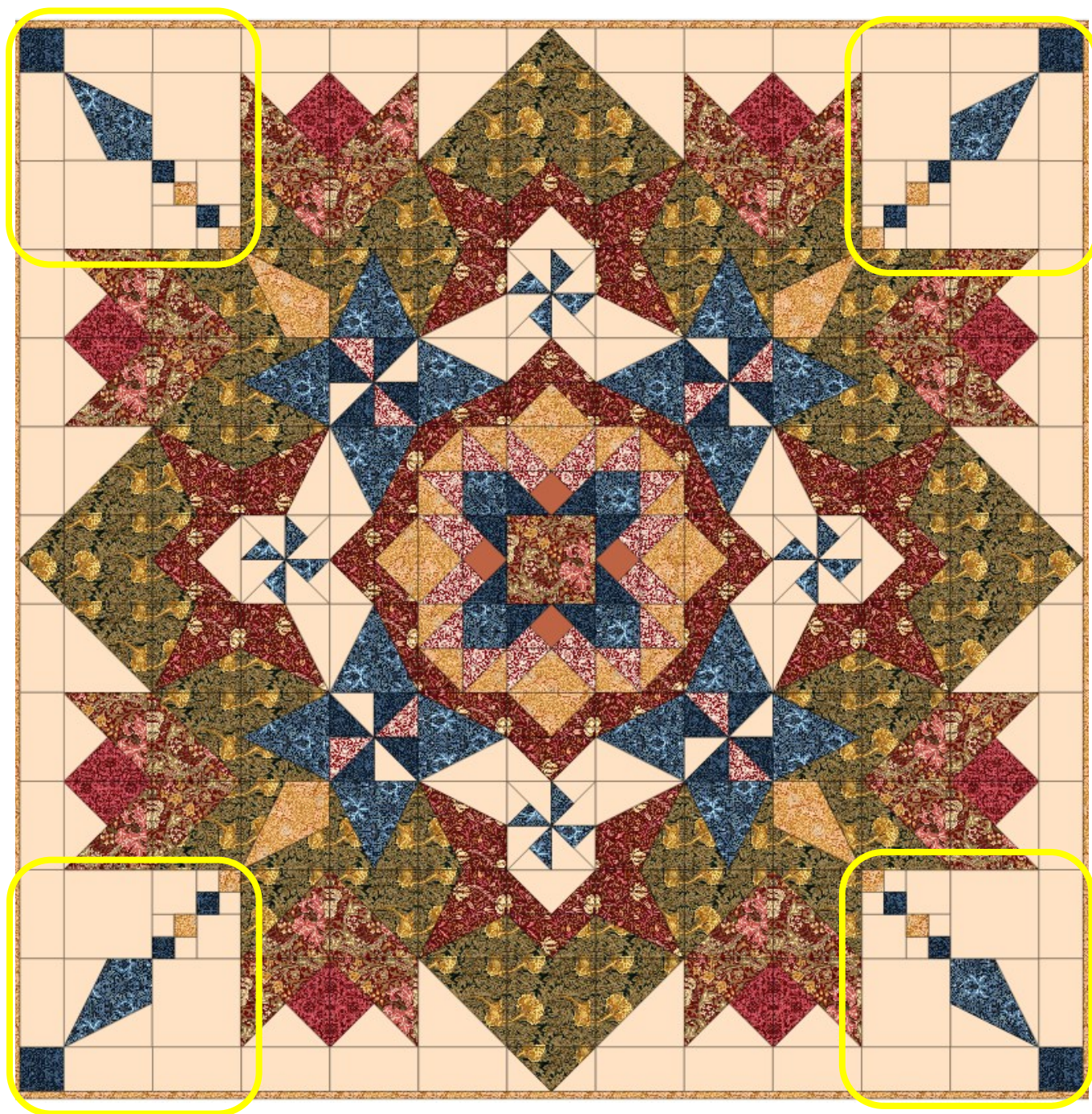


February Outer Border section 3

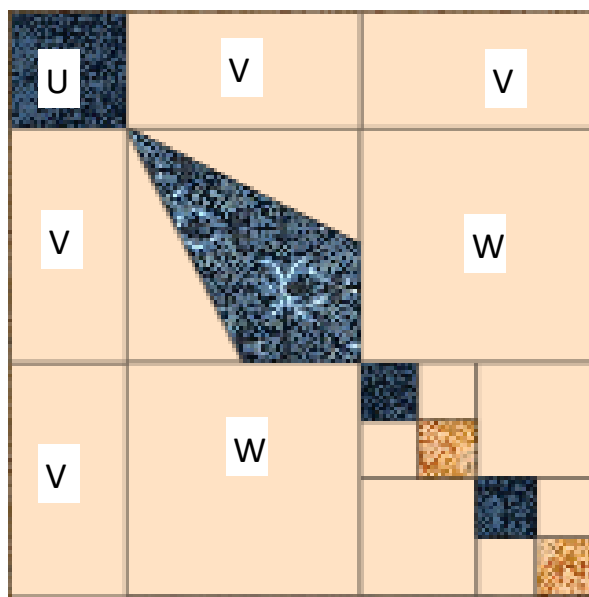
Month 6 Blocks U, V, W, X, & Y

For Month 6 you will make the final 4 sections to be used in the final border of of the quilt. Where appropriate you will be referred to previous months instructions. After you complete section 3, you are ready to finish piecing your quilt top by adding the final rows.

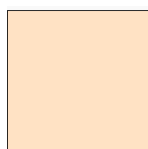
You will be following the instructions for the Kite Block from Month 3.

Block Y

Step 1—Cut (2) 3 1/2" squares per block. Your quilt will need 8 total for the four blocks you will be making

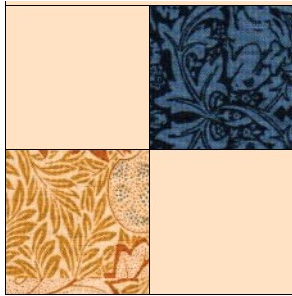

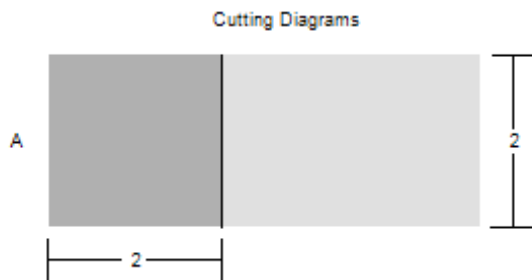
Cut (8) 3 1/2" squares

Block Y - 4 Patch Block




Step 2: Make (8) 4-patch units that are 3 1/2" Square. As this is the last section of the program, and playing with smaller pieces of fabric, we give you two options to make the 4-Patch. The basic way, cutting 2" squares and making your 4-Patch blocks. Or cutting 2" strips and attaching one Background to a Dark blue and another strip with Gold and Background. Sub cut these strips into 2" squares and then assemble them.

Basic method—Assemble as shown



Dark Blue  Cut (8) 2" Squares

Gold  Cut (8) 2" squares

Background  Cut (16) 2" squares

Strip method

Dark Blue  Cut (1) 2" x 18" strip

Gold  Cut (1) 2" x 18" strip

Background  Cut (2) 2" x 18" strip

4. Sub cut 8 2" rectangles from your two strips



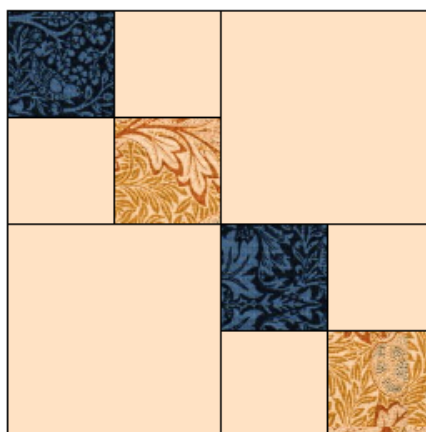
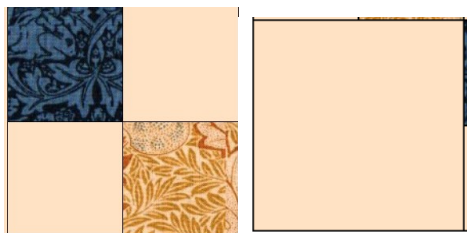
1. Cut your strips 18" which is a little longer than needed.
2. With the Dark Blue strip and one of the Background strips, place them with right sides together and join along the long edge with a scant 1/4" seam. Press to the Dark Blue.
3. Repeat with your Gold fabric and remaining Background strip.



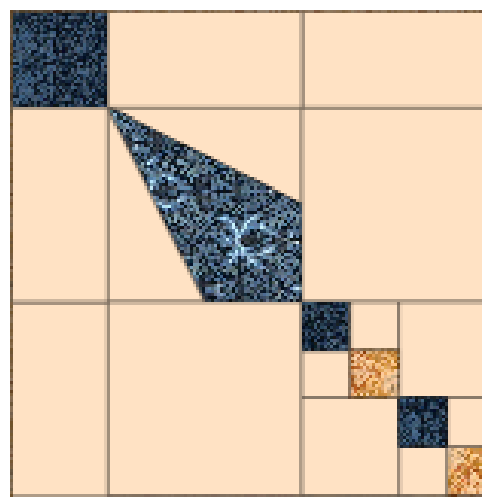
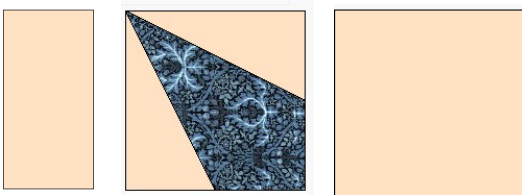
5. Assemble as shown until you have 8 4-patch 3 1/2" Squares
